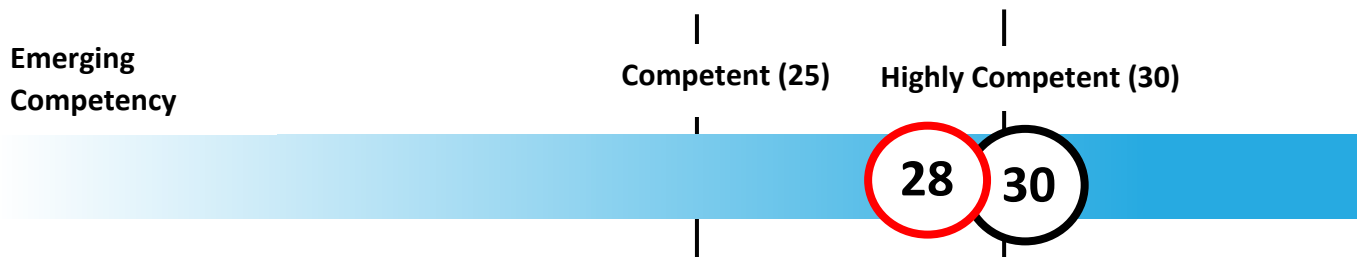
Bravery
